
Reshape Welt Pocket Flaps

Welt pockets are decorative detail many of us avoid as too difficult but with practice and a few tricks they are easily accomplished. The easiest trick is to reduce the bulk in the edges of the flaps. Here are the easy steps to making a bulk free pocket flap.

Trace the flap pattern without seam allowances. Measure $\frac{3}{4}$ " in from the outside edges of one long side of the pattern. Draw a line from the fold line to the $\frac{3}{4}$ " dot. Cut out the pattern paper, and then cut along the angled line. Pivot the cut corner down, see drawing below



Trace the adjusted pattern to another piece of paper and add ¼" seam allowances to all the cut edges.
