TAG SUGGESTIONS FOR SELECTING A SEWING MACHINE

BASIC FUNCTIONS AND FEATURES:

Have a straight stitch, zigzag stitch (length and width of both stitches should be adjustable).

Have a reverse.

Have a bobbin winder

Have a top loading drop in bobbin.

Have a "free arm" configuration.

Have a light.

NICE ADDITIONS:

Speed control

Needle up or down feature

Button hole foot

Decorative stitches

Additional "feet" (zipper, hemming, etc. and tools) included with purchase.

WHERE TO PURCHASE: Big Box Stores VS a Dealership

There can be a substantial \$\$\$ gap between machines from big box and dealerships. Each manufacturer produces high, medium, and low cost product lines and that is reflected in the pricing. Extra features and hardware (what feet/tools are included), also how many tutoring sessions are included (one on one machine intro tutorials), phone troubleshooting, and available repair services are also a part of the cost difference. Access to an experienced sewist may mean you don't need some of these services HOWEVER frustration with a machine is the number one reason machines are banished to the closet.
