We have had many questions on the workings of the email notifications we send out. Markita has kindly volunteered to document and screen shot the steps for signing up. She has included information on how to unsubscribe from any one email without unsubscribing from all as this seems to be an ongoing issue. Below she will walk you through what needs to be done to receive the emails you want from our email notification service. Here goes...

How do I change my email notifications?

Look for this text at the bottom of this email:

"Want to change how you receive these emails?

You can or <u>unsubscribe from this list</u>.


update your preferences"



If you choose unsubscribe from this list; you will no longer receive ANY emails from Plano ASG!!!



To see all of the groups and to be included on the specific emails, click on "update your preferences" you will get a notification. Click on the "Send me a




Link" button.

For security, this will send you an email (to the email in our mail system). In a few minutes you will see an email




with this text. Again click on "update

groups and email lists are listed here (there are 2 pages so don't forget to scroll down! The check means you are getting the email updates from these groups, no check - no email.






